Aims and Objectives


• Create a new clubhouse to house ASLSC and other water-based beach groups (surfers, swimmers, dippers etc)

Location and Planning - Current

- Volunteer since 1996
- No facilities
- No ramp access
- Groynes altered Surf
 - Lifesaving sessions for beginners are at the mercy of the tides
- Groynes are hazardous and reduce the number of sessions we can safely run.


• Existing Toilet block

Location and Planning - Proposal

- Designed by Council employed architects
- ABC Input a list of facilities
- Drawings are not final or to scale
- Design includes retaining public toilet access
 - Council to assess potential of alternative locations



Location and Planning - Benefits

- Away from Groynes
- Prefered Swim location
- More visibility safety and promotion of activities
- Rips/currents more predictable and manageable
- Access to existing Ramp
- Shelter dominant wave approach from the northeast, 40% of the time (Ramsay and Brampton, 2000)
